Figure 2 (p. 48) in this article is replaced by the following figure, in which the various symbols are more easily distinguished than in the original figure.

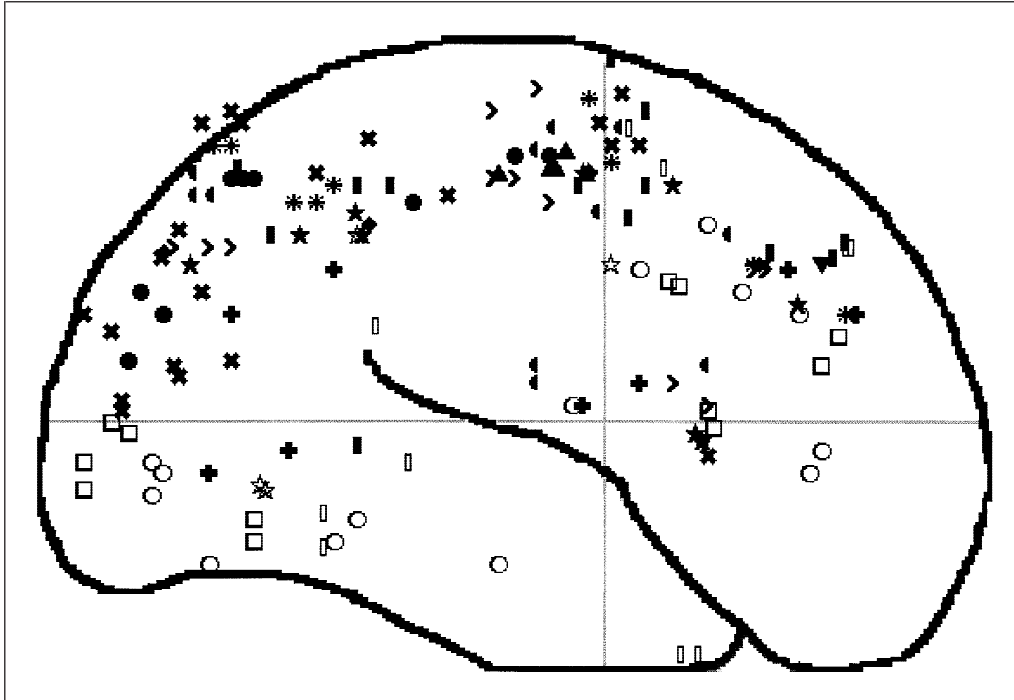


Fig. 2. Schematic of the right side of the cortex, showing regions of activation for spatial (filled symbols) and object (open symbols) working memory tasks in humans (adapted from Smith & Jonides, 1999). The results are drawn from 11 different experiments, with different symbols being used for different experiments. Not all the activations occurred on the surface of the brain, so the schematic should be interpreted as a glass brain—as though one were looking through the brain from the side.
