She was one of 12 researchers to be honored. The National Medal of Science, along with the National Medal of Technology and Innovation, is the highest honor that the US government grants to scientists, engineers, and inventors. Treisman is an expert on visual attention and is known for her research examining how humans turn sensory information into meaningful thoughts, memories, and actions.
