Tackett Named Editor of Clinical Psychological Science

APS Fellow **Jennifer Tackett** has been selected as the new editor of <u>Clinical Psychological Science</u>, to begin her tenure on January 1, 2021. Tackett is a professor and director of clinical psychology at Northwestern University. As head of the <u>Personality Across Development lab</u>, she leads a team of researchers investigating how the personalities of children and adolescents relate to behaviors such as decision making, psychopathologies, and academic outcomes.

Tackett has a wealth of editorial experience, having previously served as a special associate editor for <u>Perspectives on Psychological Science</u> editing Registered Replication Reports and as one of the first associate editors of APS's newest journal, <u>Advances in Methods and Practices in Psychological Science</u>. She has also been an associate editor for the *Journal of Abnormal Psychology*, the *Journal of Personality*, the *Journal of Psychopathology and Behavioral Assessment*, the *Journal of Research in Personality*, the *Journal of Personality Disorders*, and *Assessment*.
